

# WINDOWS ON YOUR WORLD

## 5. DREAMCATCHERS

### POSSIBLE PROMPTS



Injecting intermittent prompt questions at periodic intervals expands participant's thinking. If participants are slow to start resist any urge to put words in their mouths.

Leave a reasonable time between each prompt question.

Suggested sequences of prompt questions for each activity include:

## 2 SHARING LEARNING

As in previous Sharing Learning activities identify the 'artist' of the images and ask the other participants to describe what they see in it.

- What do you see in this drawing?
- Where is this?
- What is it?
- What are windows for?
- What colours do you see?
- What is this thing made of?
- What sort of window is this?
- How does it open?
- How would you describe this type of window?
- What do you see through the window?
- What do you call the group of things you see through the window?
- What happens inside when the sun shines through a window?

- When you painted the Sunshine and Shadows what happened to the window's shadow pattern on the floor?
- What made this happen?
- Do you remember what happened to the sun?

### **3 WHAT'S YOUR FAVOURITE WINDOW NOW?**

Describe your favourite window of all those you've seen in the last few weeks.

- What sort of window is this?
- What do you like about it?
- What's around the window?
- What holds the frame?
- Have a go at drawing what's around the window?
- What buildings do you know with windows like this?
- What do you do inside the building/room that has this window?
- What do you see when you look through this window?

#### **Sharing Learning**

Invite each group of six to describe what they see in the six different drawings.

- Where is this window?
- What sort of window is it?
- What shape of window is this?
- What is it made from?

## 4 YOUR DREAM HOUSE

Prompts encouraging participants to give free rein to their creativity include:

- What makes your dream house truly magical?
- What kinds of magical things can you see inside and outside when you look through the dream windows in your dream house?
- Where is your dream house?
- What does it look like from the outside?
- What does it look like on the inside?
- What does it look like at night time?
- What makes it feel truly fantastic?
- What's around it?
- How do the people in your family feel about it?
- How do the people in your class feel about it?
- Who are the people using it?
- What age are they?
- What do they do here?
- Where do they come from?
- Who owns your dream house with the amazing windows?
- Who looks after it on the inside
- Who looks after it on the outside?
